Photovoice Project

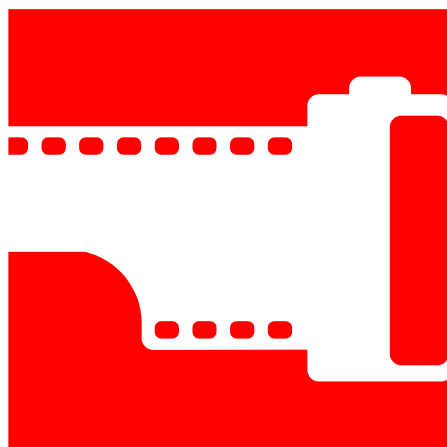
The *Photovoice* project is used as a tool to engage youth in taking responsibility to identify tobacco-related concerns in their neighborhoods. It promotes conversation and greater understanding of important tobacco-related issues captured by the youth through their photographs.

This project focuses on tobacco use and its impact on the health of the neighborhood. It describes:

- Nicotine as an addictive substance
- Tobacco and its harmful effects in a neighborhood
- Marketing to specific audiences
- Tobacco prevention and help with cessation

Youth using *Photovoice*:

- Take photographs that most accurately reflect their neighborhoods' tobacco-related concerns
- Tell stories about what the photographs mean through the youth's perspective
