Sample Tobacco-Free Campus and Vehicle Policy

PurposeA tobacco-free policy has been adopted. [Business] is committed to
promoting the health, well-being, and safety of everyone on our
campus. Tobacco uses poses serious health risks to the tobacco
user and to nonsmokers who are exposed to secondhand smoke.
The policy set forth below is effective [Date] for [Business].

Smoke-FreeTobacco use is prohibited on all property owned, leased or
operated by [business]. This consists of all buildings, all grounds,

Compliance Compliance with the tobacco-free policy is mandatory for all employees and persons visiting, with no exceptions. All employees and contractors are expected to observe this policy as a condition of continued employment. All employees are authorized and encouraged to approach employees, contractors, and visitors who are violating the policy and courteously remind them of the policy. If situations arise where employees are not comfortable fulfilling this function, they should notify [manager and phone number] of violations.
