Sample Tobacco-Free **Child Care Policy**

Purpose

We are committed to promoting the health, well-being, and safety of everyone on our campus. Tobacco use poses serious health risks to the tobacco user and to nonsmokers who are exposed to secondhand smoke.

Campus

Tobacco-Free Tobacco use is prohibited on all property owned and operated by [Company]. This consists of all buildings, all grounds, including exterior open spaces, sidewalks, parking lots; and in all vehicles owned or used by [Company]. This policy includes all tobacco and nicotine products including e-cigarettes.

Sign Requirements

"Tobacco-free" signage will be prominently posted at our location.

Compliance

Compliance with this tobacco-free policy will be mandatory for all employees and persons visiting, with no exceptions. All employees and contractors are expected to observe this policy as a condition of continued employment. All employees are authorized and encouraged to approach employees, contractors, and visitors who are violating the policy and courteously remind them of the policy.
