## Sample Tobacco-Free Parks Policy

**Purpose** 

We are committed to promoting the health, well-being, and safety of everyone on our campus. Tobacco use poses serious health risks to the tobacco user and to nonsmokers who are exposed to secondhand smoke.

Tobacco-Free Campus

Tobacco use is prohibited at all parks owned and operated by the City of [insert city]. This consists of all buildings, all grounds, including exterior open spaces, sidewalks, parking lots. This policy includes all tobacco and nicotine products including e-cigarettes.

Sign Requirements "Tobacco-free" signage will be prominently posted at our location.

Compliance

Compliance with this tobacco-free policy will be mandatory for all employees and persons visiting, with no exceptions. All employees and contractors are expected to observe this policy as a condition of continued employment. All employees are authorized and encouraged to approach employees, contractors, and visitors who are violating the policy and courteously remind them of the policy. If situations arise where employees are not comfortable fulfilling this function, they should notify the city clerk.
